

# HEATSTROKE

## HOW TO IDENTIFY THE SIGNS



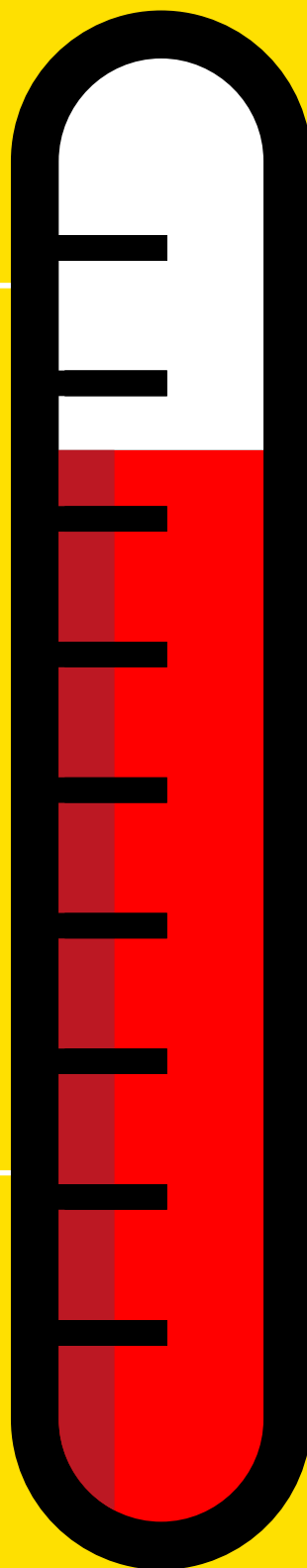
### POTENTIAL SEIZURES

- Talk to your dog softly, reassure them and avoid stroking them.
- If it lasts longer than 2 minutes, soak a cloth in cold water and place it on their paws.



### HIGH TEMPERATURE

- Check your dogs paws and ears with the back of your hand.
- Average canine temperatures should be between 101 and 102.5 degrees.



### RACING HEARTBEAT

- Place your hand on the left side of your dog's chest, behind the elbow, and count for 30 seconds.
- Should be between 65 and 160 dependent on size.

## WHAT TO DO IF YOU SUSPECT HEATSTROKE



Move your dog to somewhere cool.



Offer small amounts of tepid water.



Douse a towel with cool water.



Place a fan in front of them.



Contact your vet.
